Peace & Love Quilt (Red/green)

Wallflower Collection

Bring thoughts of peace and love to your family and friends with this feel-good quilt. It uses fabrics from the Wallflower collection, a lovely range of fabrics that are romantic and ornamental with a retro vibe. This quilt uses predominantly greens, pinks and reds on a sage-coloured Chambray background and there is another quilt in this design using soothing blue and caramel fabrics on a sand-coloured background.



Materials (see fabric note)

- Fabric 1: 5yds (4.6m) – Chambray sage (160011) (background)
- Fabric 2: a fat eighth * – Lauren green (100601)
- Fabric 3: ¼yd (25cm) – Lauren burgundy (100602)
- Fabric 4: ¼yd (25cm) – Wallflower green (100605)
- Fabric 5: ½yd (50cm) – Wallflower burgundy (100606)
- Fabric 6: ½yd (50cm) – Beverly green (100609)
- Fabric 7: ½yd (50cm) – Beverly pink (100610)
- Fabric 8: ½yd (50cm) – Janice green (100613)
- Fabric 9: ½yd (50cm) – Janice red (100614)
- Fabric 10: ½yd (50cm) – Bianca green (100617)
- Fabric 11: ½yd (50cm) – Bianca red (100618)
- Fabric 12: a fat eighth * – Bellflower teal (110126)
- Fabric 13: a fat eighth * – Bellflower pine (110127)
- Fabric 14: a fat eighth * – Bellflower green (110128)
- Fabric 15: a fat eighth * – Bellflower pink (110129)
- Fabric 16: a fat eighth * – Bellflower flaxen (110130)
- Fabric 17: a fat eighth * – Bellflower denim (110131)
- Wadding (batting): 71in x 90in (180.5cm x 229cm)
- Backing fabric: 5yds (4.6m) – Bellflower green (110128)
- Binding fabric: ⅝yd (60cm) – Chambray sage (160011)
- Piecing and quilting threads
- Quilter's ruler, rotary cutter and mat

Finished Size

63in x 82½in (160cm x 209.5cm)

Fabric Note

Where a long quarter of a yard is given in the Materials list you could use a fat quarter instead, which is assumed to be a cut of approximately 21in x 18in (53.3cm x 45.7cm).

* Where a fat eighth is given in the Materials list, a long ⅝yd can't be used as the cut isn't deep enough. A fat eighth is assumed to be approximately 10½in x 18in (26.7cm x 45.7cm).



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
