

## Sanctuary Pillow (Warm)

Sanctuary Collection

These stylised little patchwork house blocks are so easy to make that even beginners will enjoy the sewing. Two pillow designs are supplied in warm and cold colourways, which will make perfect companions to the Sanctuary Quilts.


## Fabric Note

Where a fat eighth is given in the Materials list, the cut is assumed to be approximately $101 / 2 \mathrm{in} \times 18 \mathrm{in}(26.7 \mathrm{~cm}$ $x 45.7 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Note that a long $1 / 8 y d(15 \mathrm{~cm})$ cannot be used as it will be insufficient, depth-wise.

## Materials

- Fabric 1: about a 6 in ( 15 cm ) square - Adina maroon (100561)
- Fabric 2: a fat eighth (not a long $1 / 8 y d$ ) - Sanctuary warm (100562)
- Fabric 3: about a 9 in ( 23 cm ) square - Daisydream rhubarb (100563)
- Fabric 4: about a 6 in $(15 \mathrm{~cm})$ square - Cottonfield maroon (100564)
- Fabric 5: about a 9in ( 23 cm ) square - Larissa rhubarb (100565)
- Fabric 6: about a 6 in $(15 \mathrm{~cm})$ square - Sanctuary caramel (100567)
- Fabric 7: a fat eighth (not a long $1 / 8 y d)$ - Daisydream $\tan (100568)$
- Fabric 8: about a 9in ( 23 cm ) square - Cottonfield ochre (100569)
- Fabric 9: about a 9in ( 23 cm ) square - Mira pink (110106)
- Fabric 10: a fat eighth (not a long $1 / 8 y d)$ - Mira ochre (110108)
- Fabric 11: about a 6 in ( 15 cm ) square - Chambray petrol ( 160005 )
- Fabric 12: about a 6 in $(15 \mathrm{~cm})$ square - Chambray blue (160008)
- Fabric 13: about a 6 in $(15 \mathrm{~cm})$ square - Chambray sage (160011)
- Fabric 14: about a 6 in $(15 \mathrm{~cm})$ square - Chambray prussian (160031)
- Fabric for back of pillow: $3 / 4 \mathrm{yd}(75 \mathrm{~cm})$ - Mira rhubarb (110105)
- Binding fabric: $1 / 4 \mathrm{yd}(25 \mathrm{~cm})$ - Chambray mustard (160042)
- Five buttons for back fastening (optional):

Sanctuary Buttons 18 mm (400066)
